

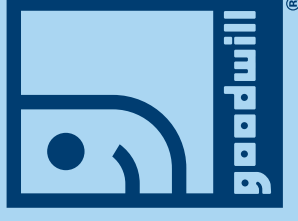
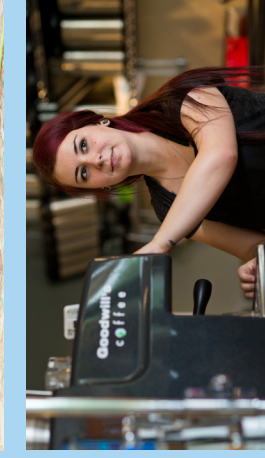
“Goodwill really
